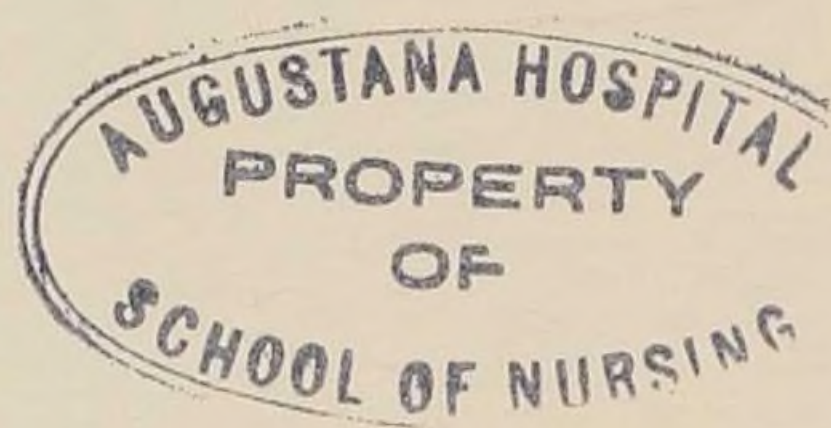

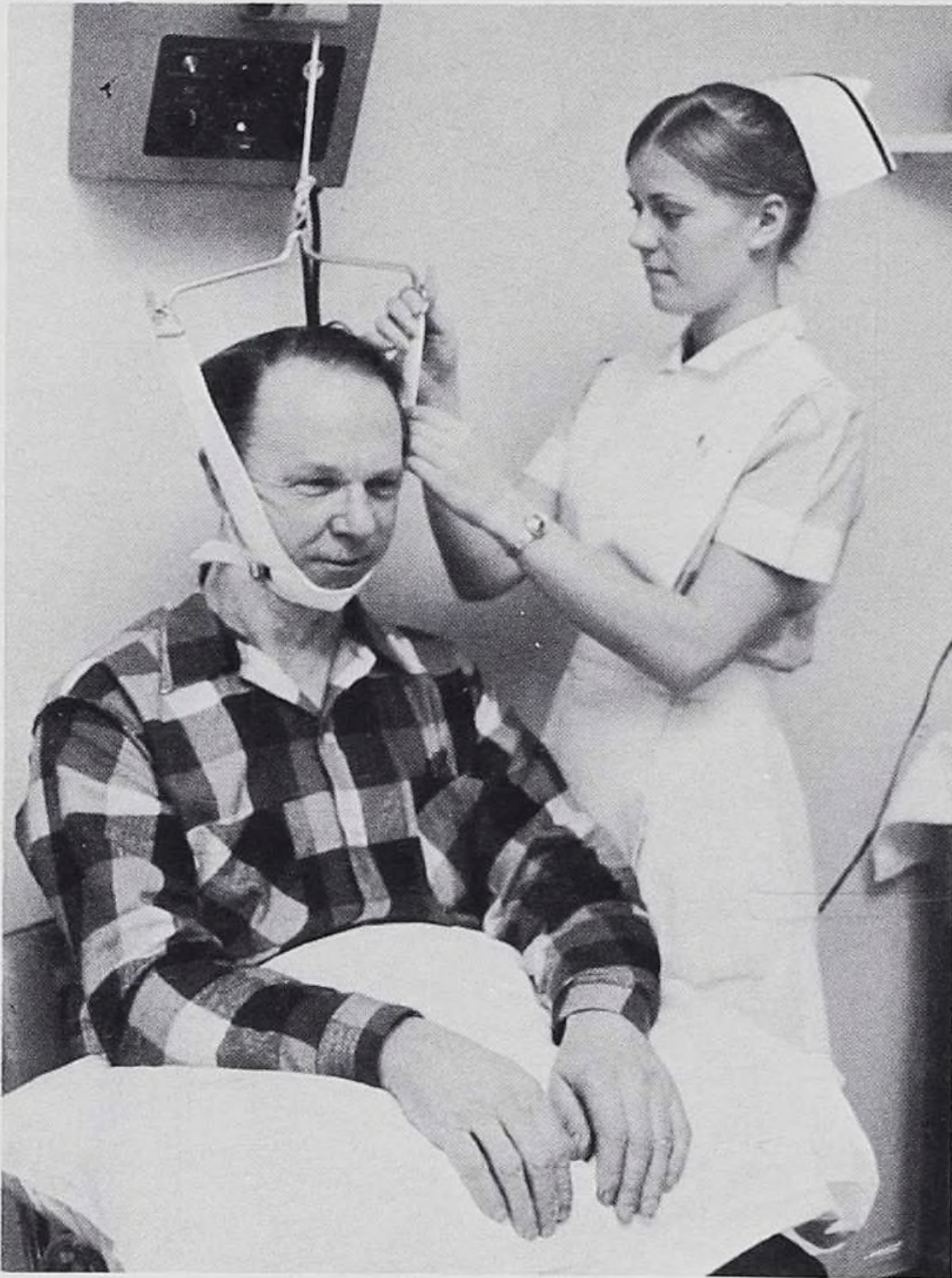




"Scientists know only what love does.
