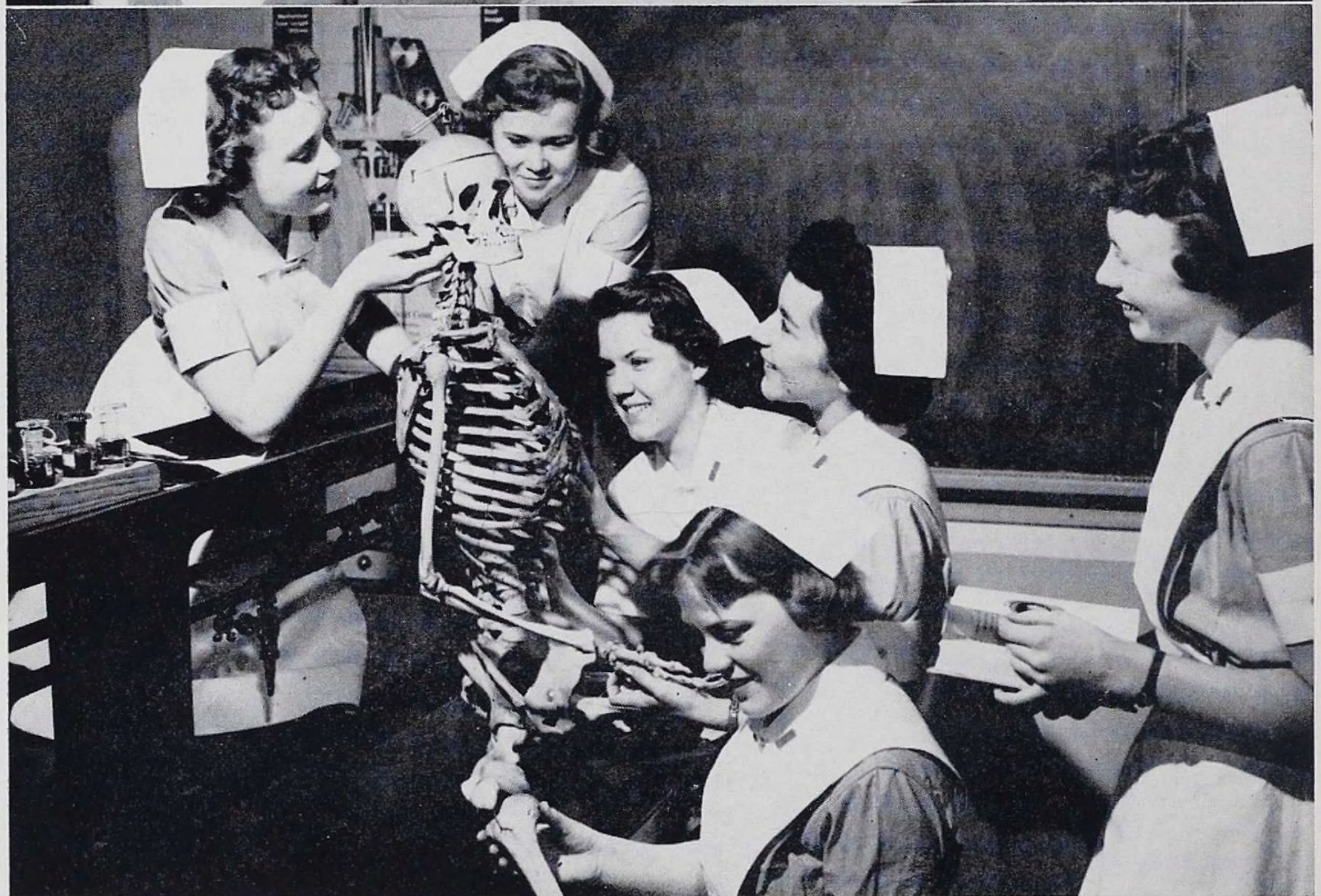
Many wonderful moments will never be forgotten, including our prayer meetings to finding corn flakes in our beds or better yet — no beds!!!

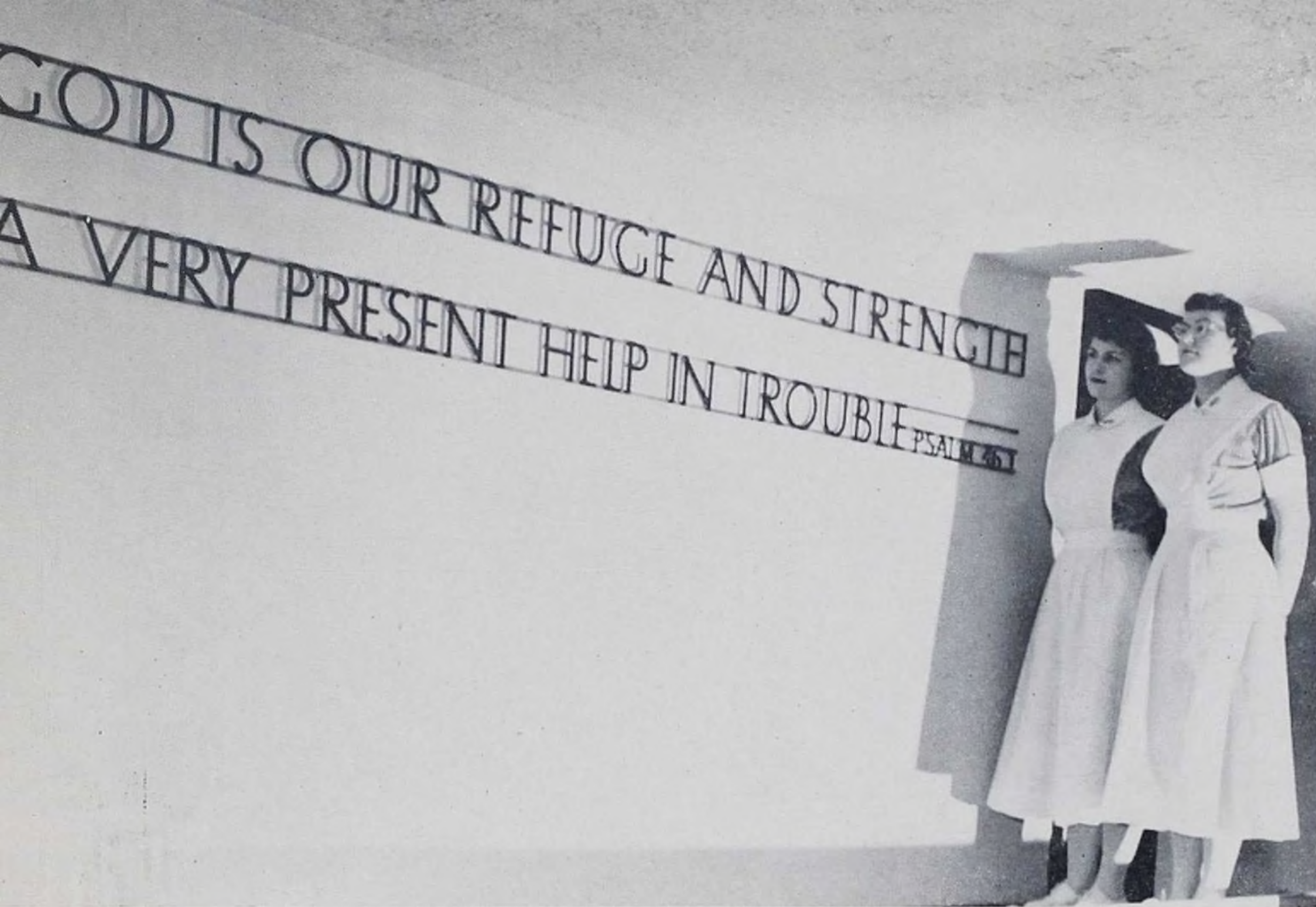
