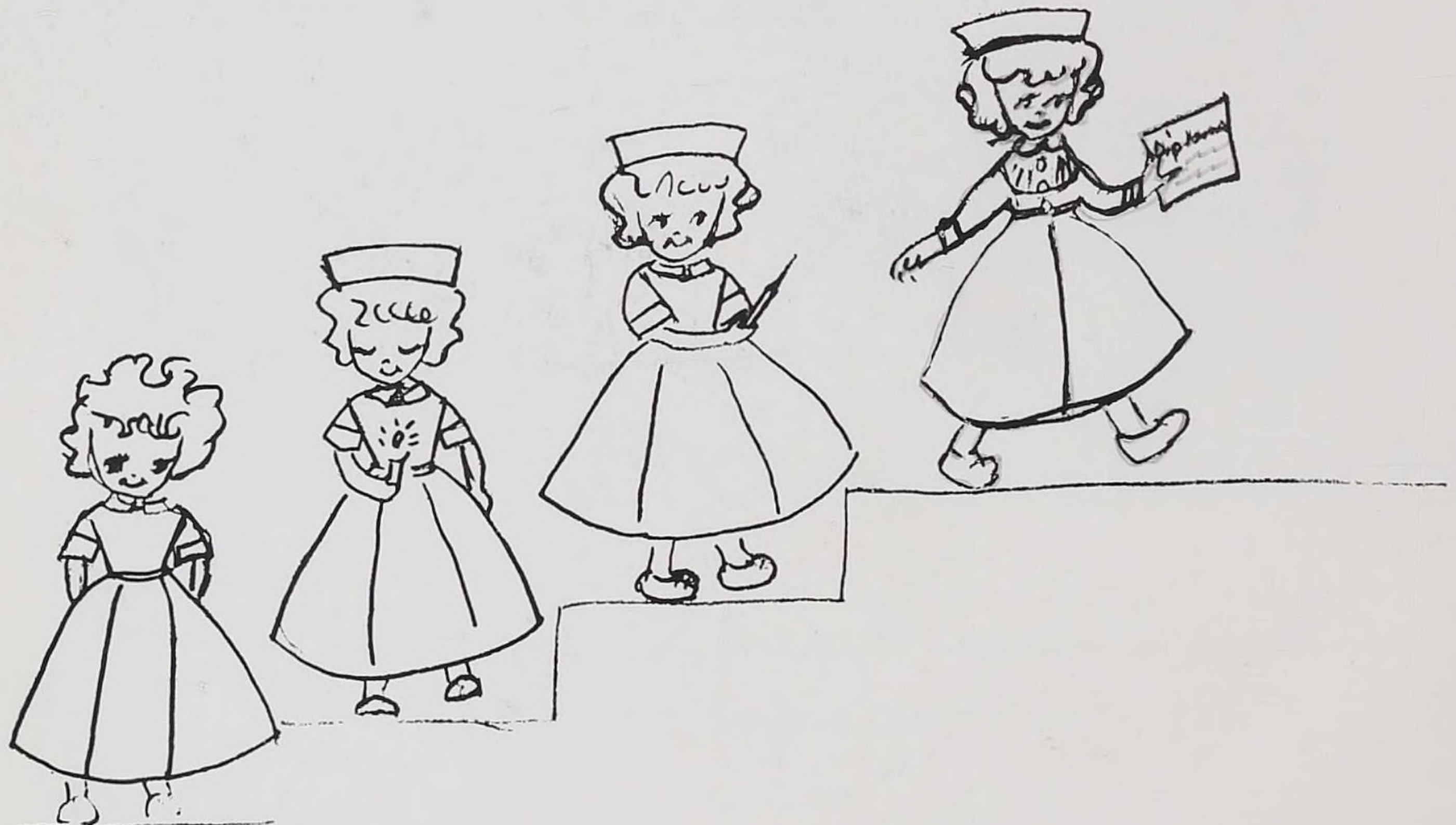

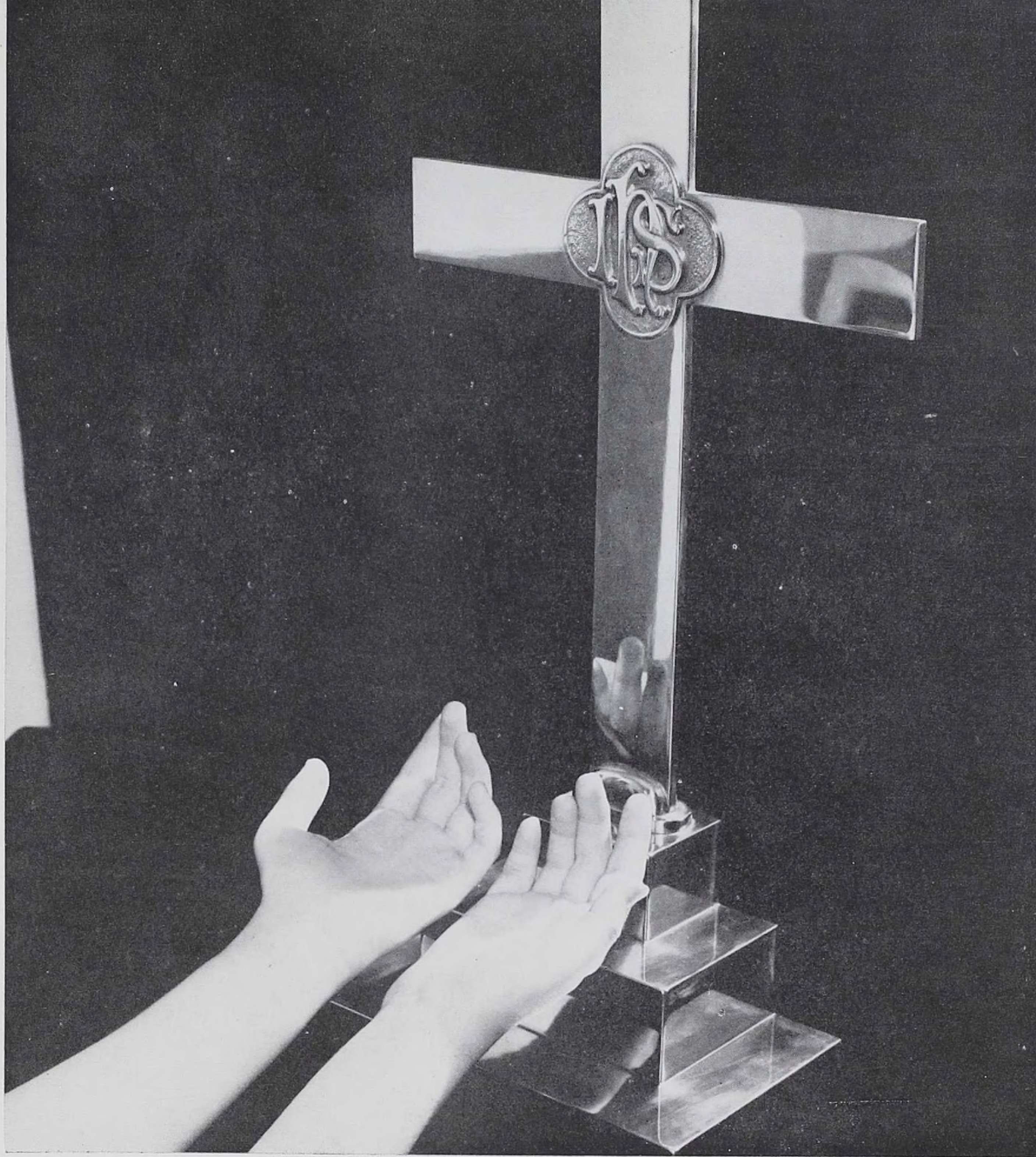
Another Year has passed at L.D.H., a year filled with many events, never to be forgotten memories and cherished friendships; a year that has brought us one step closer to our goal.

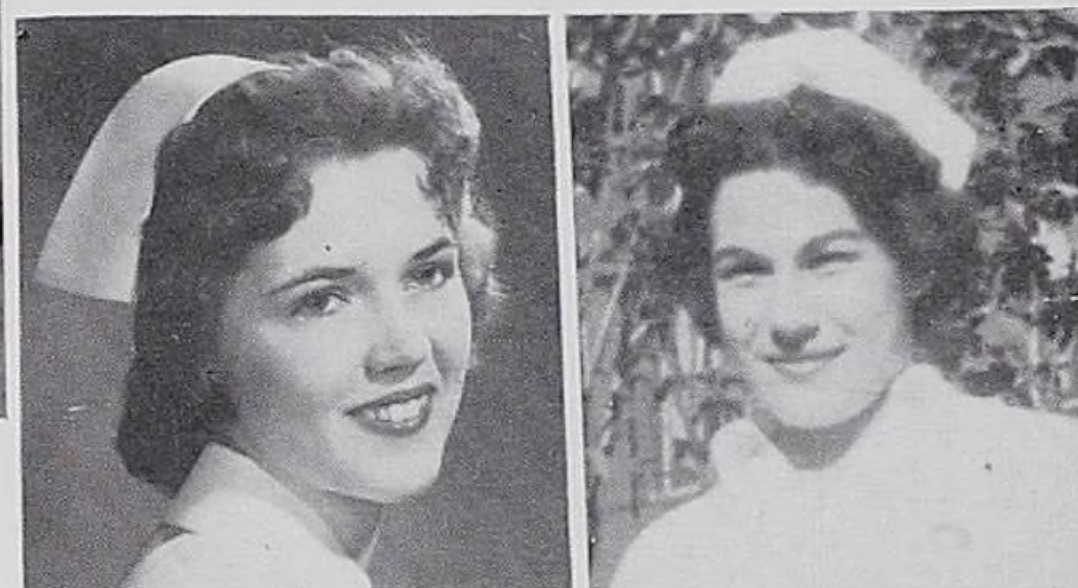
Class of 1958 — Juniors

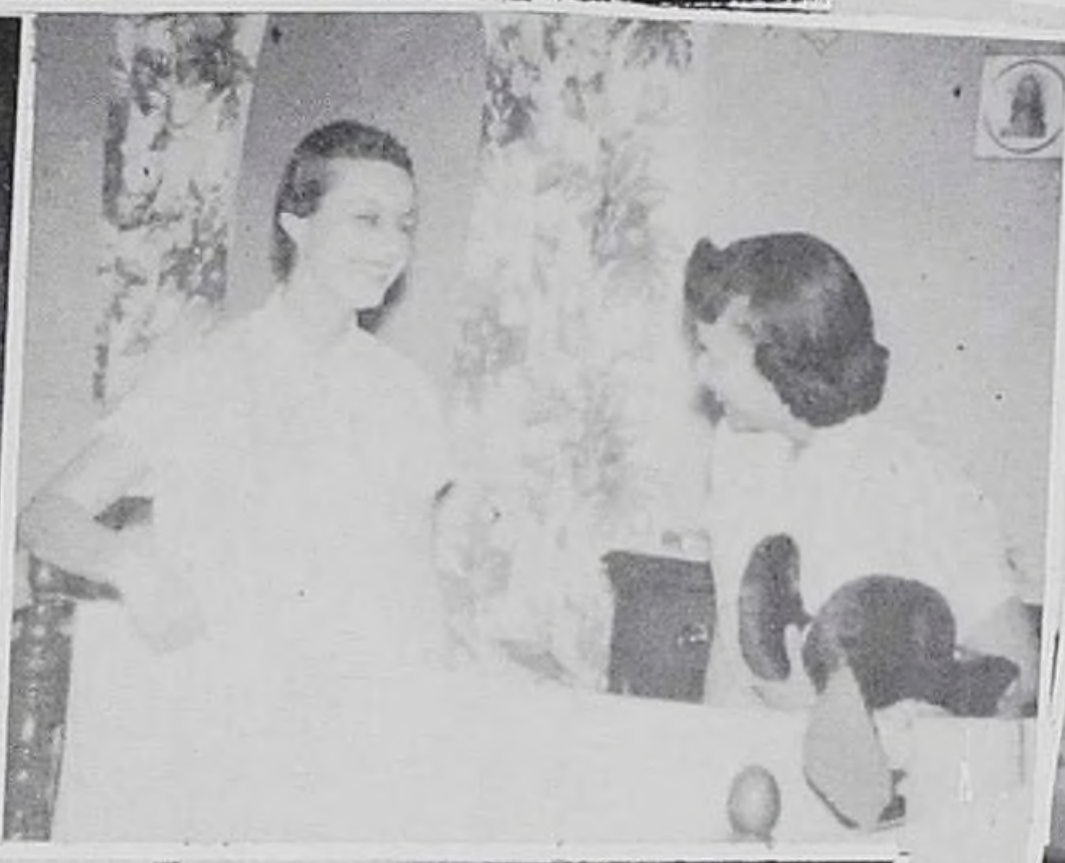
Soon we'll receive our three bar pins and then on to the white uniform.
