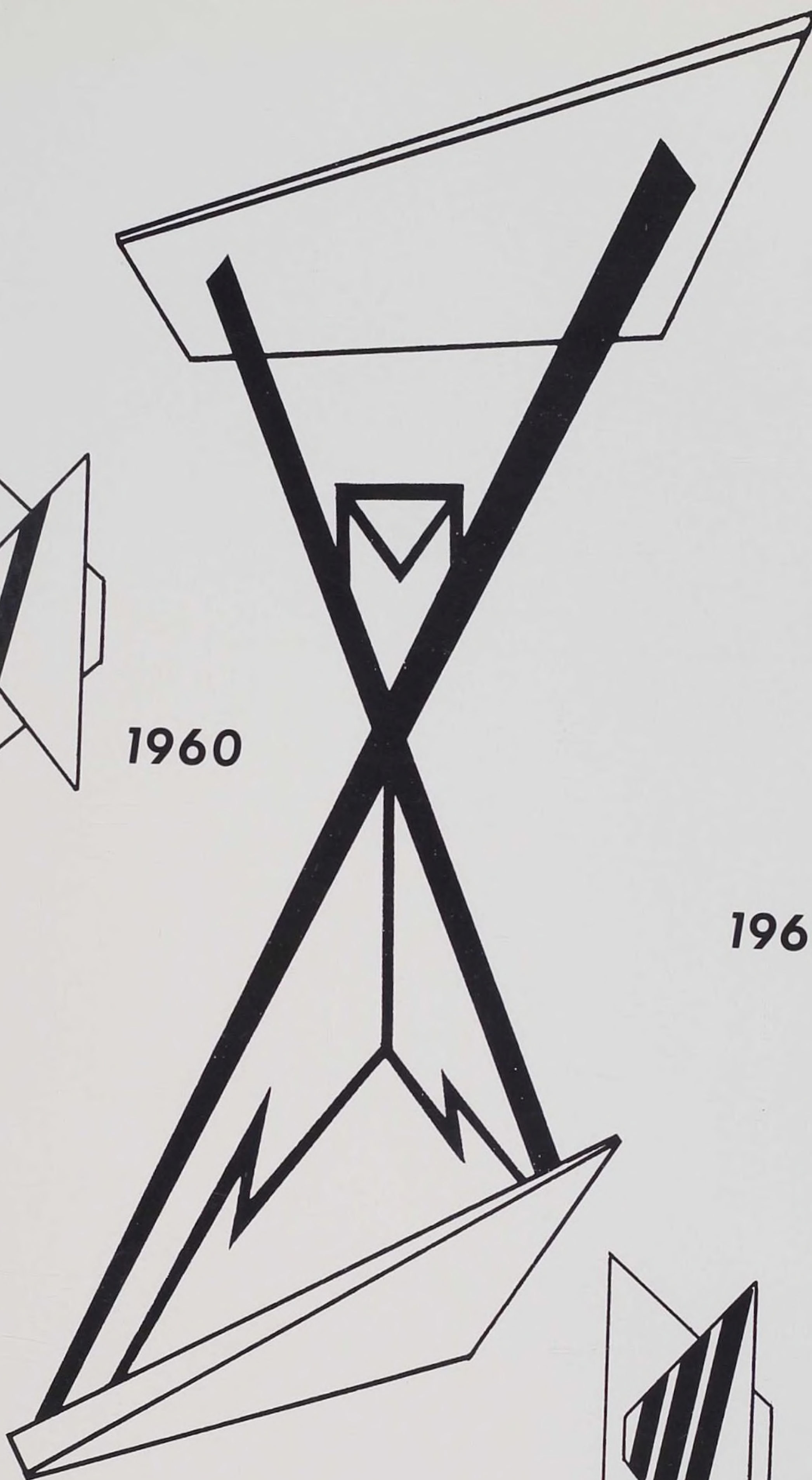
In order to facilitate recalling the hospital, dorm, our colleagues, co-workers, and superiors; we present this yearbook to you.

These, then, are the activities engaged in during the growth toward becoming a professional nurse - IN THREE YEARS.



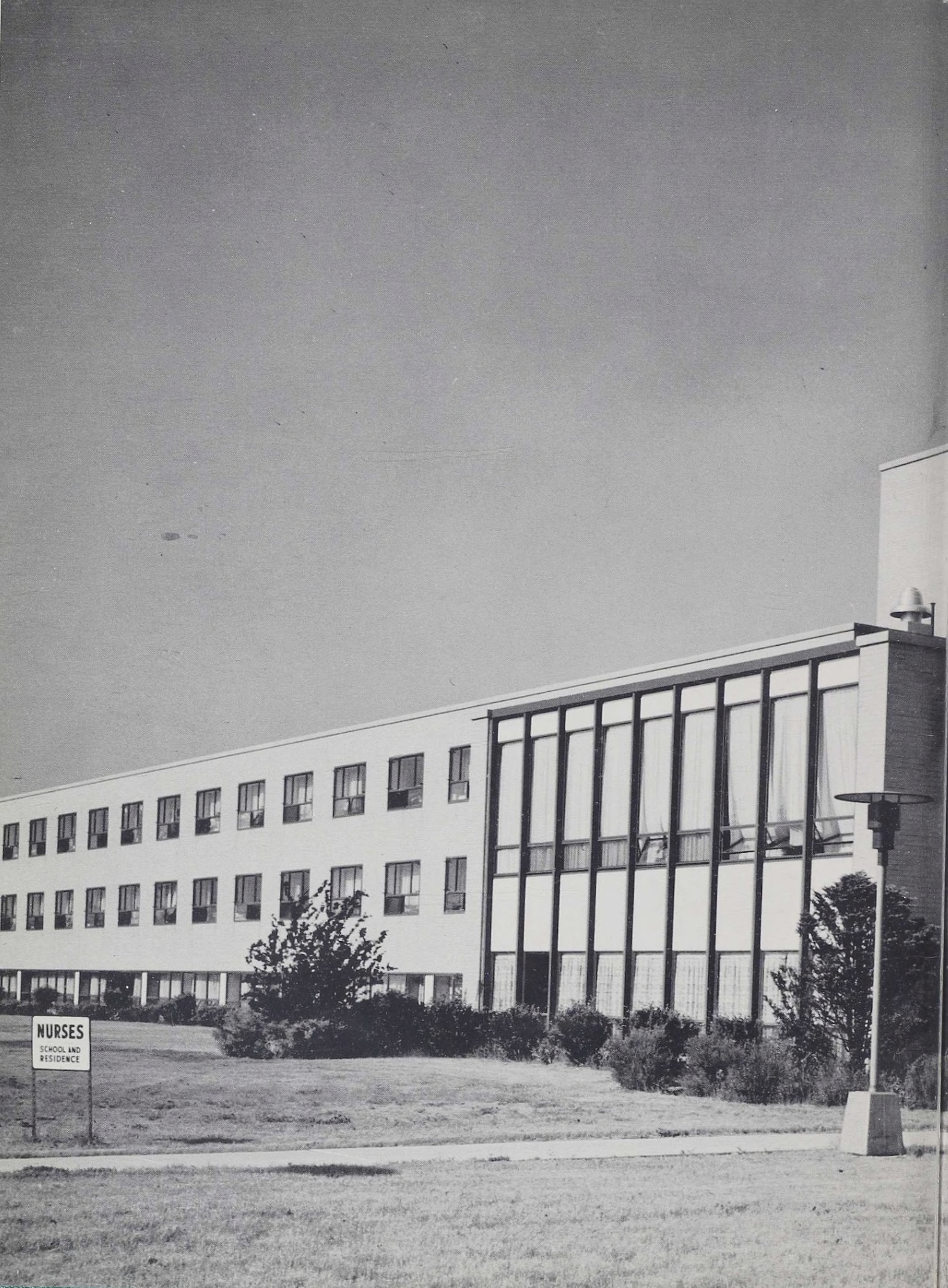
