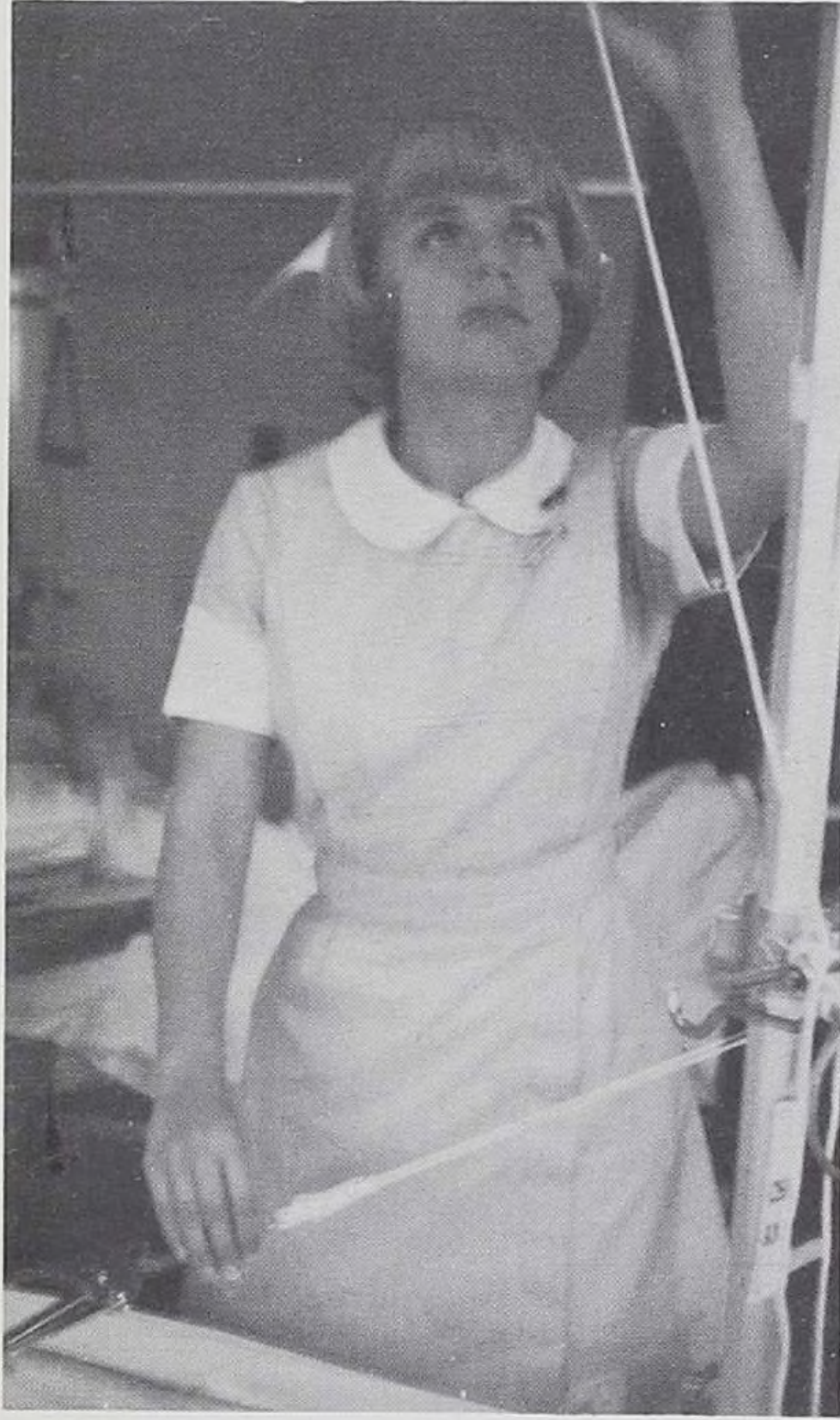




RECOVERY ROOM

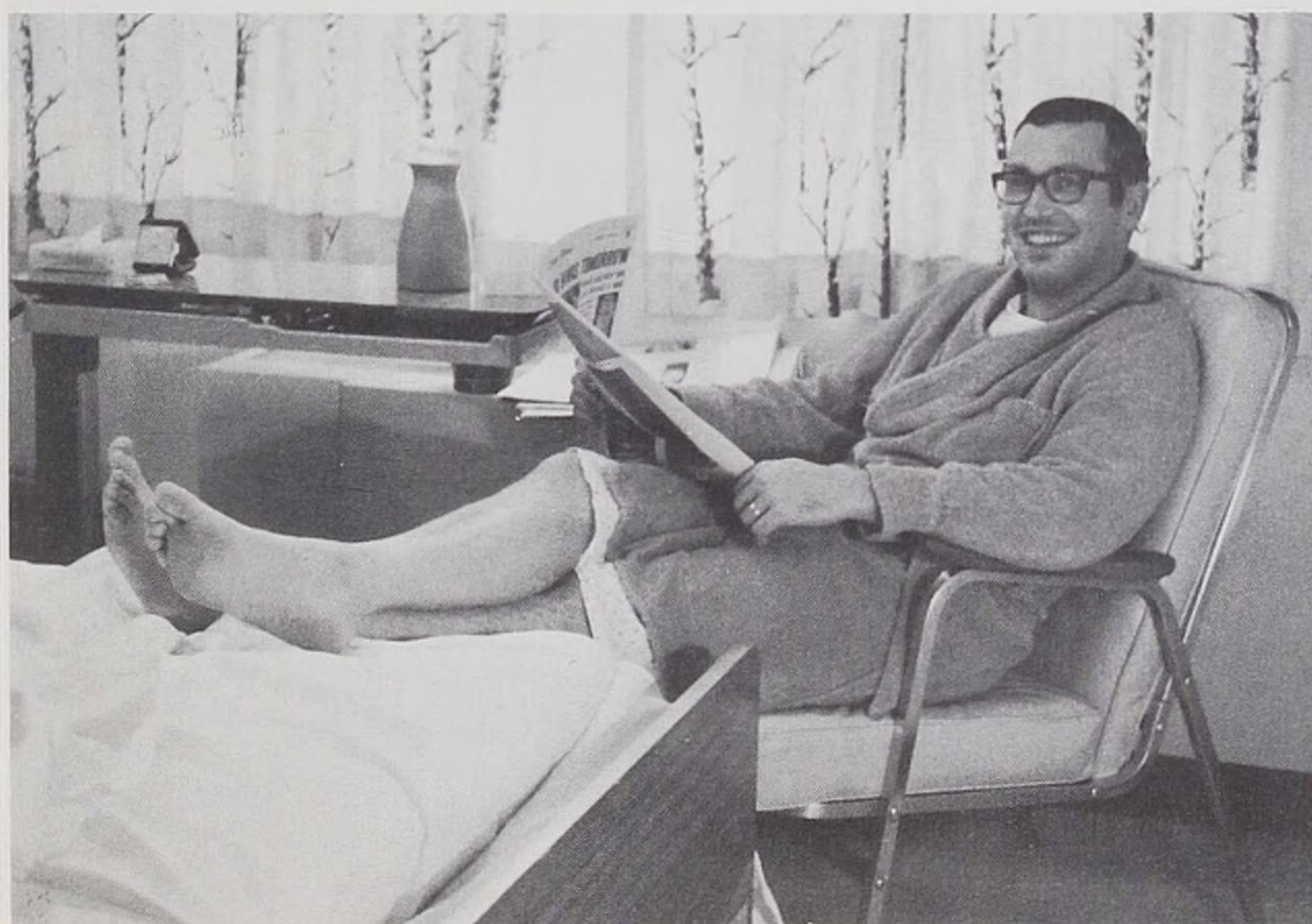
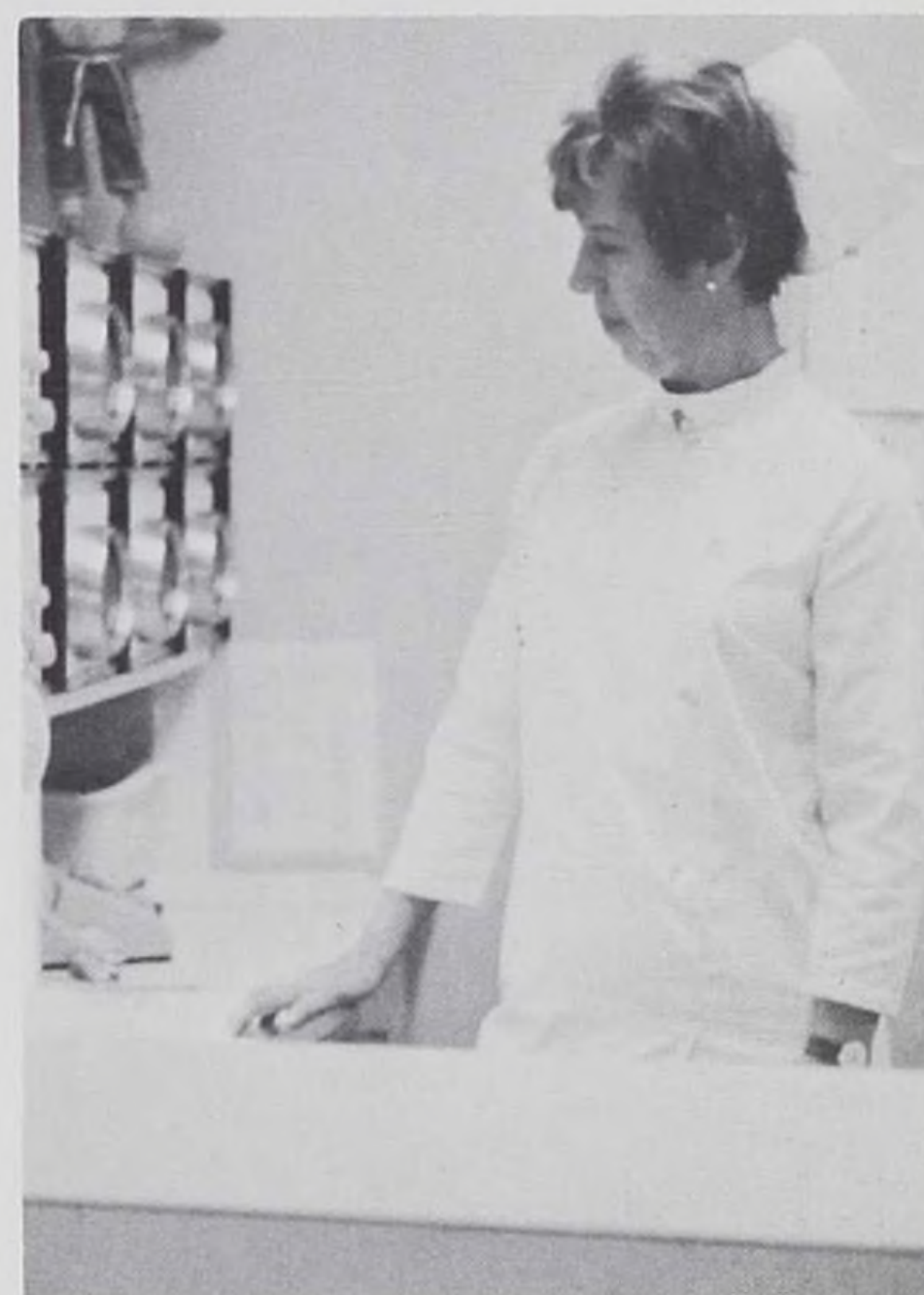




I.C.U.

The intensive care unit plays an important part at a critical moment in a patient's life. Here intensive surveillance and specialized equipment along with tender loving care help the patient through his critical phase.



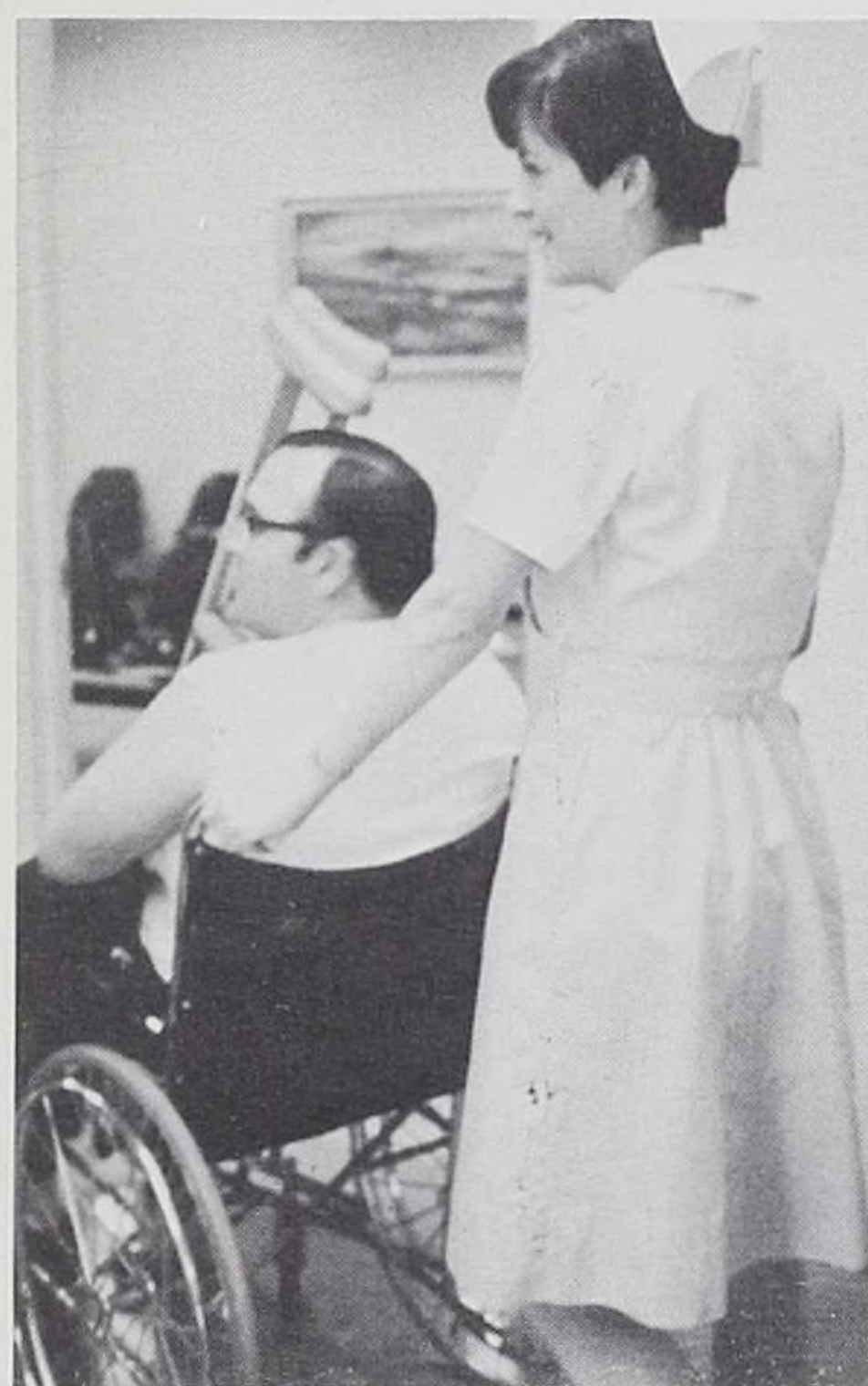
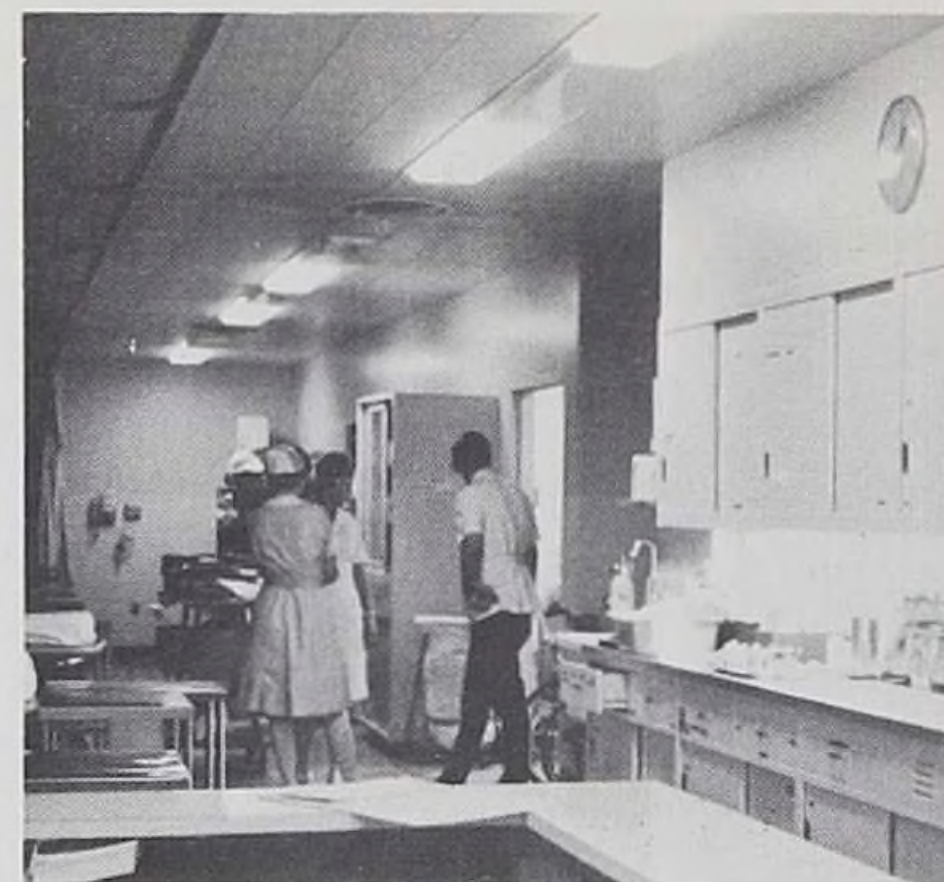
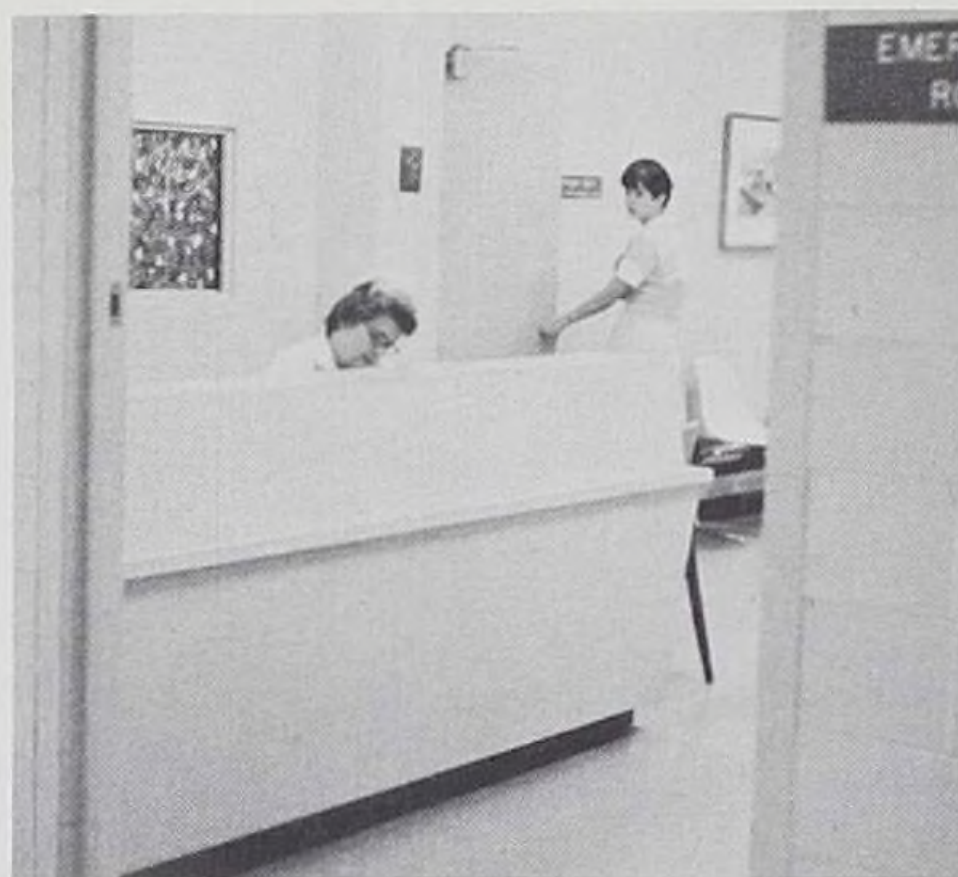


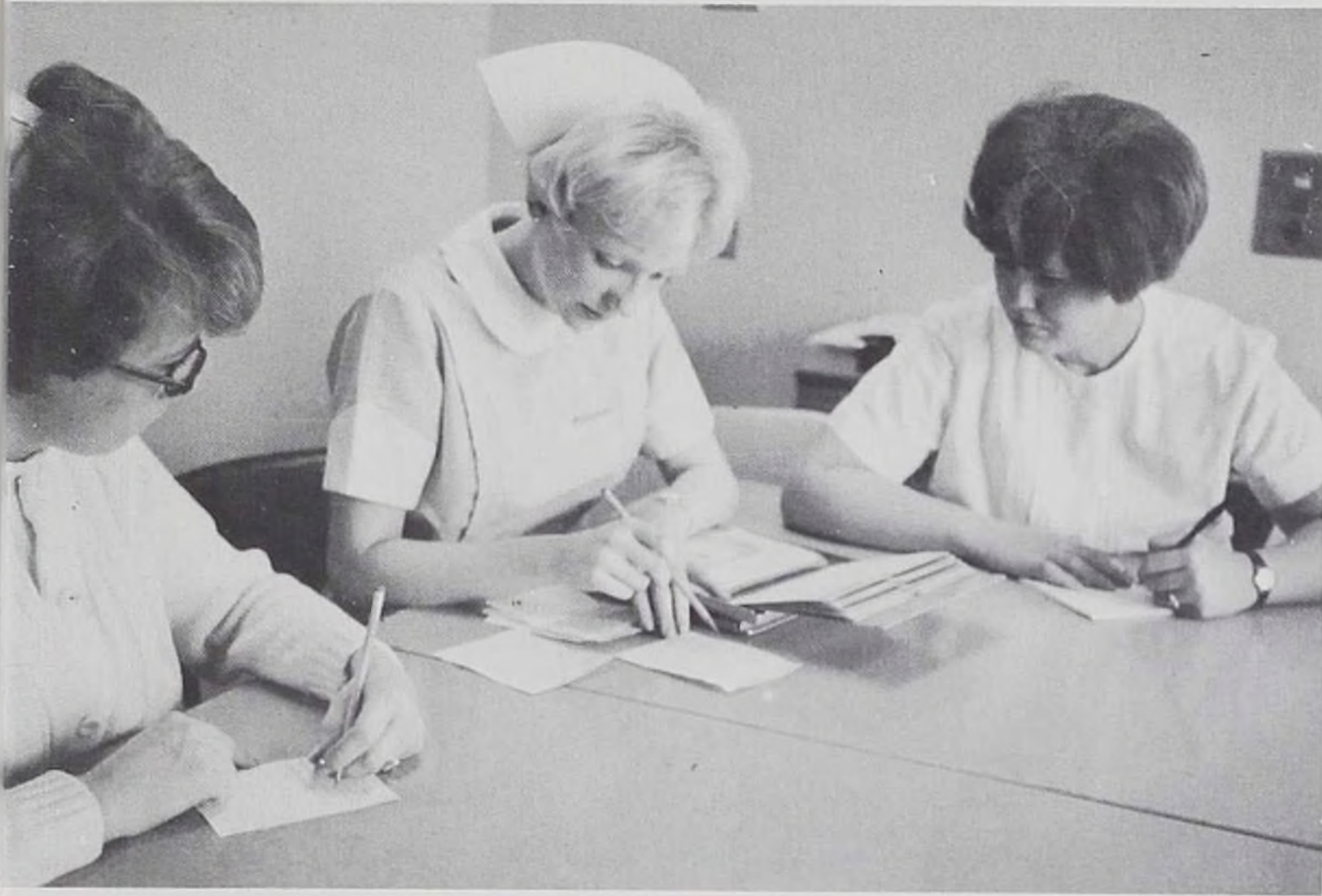
C.C.U.
