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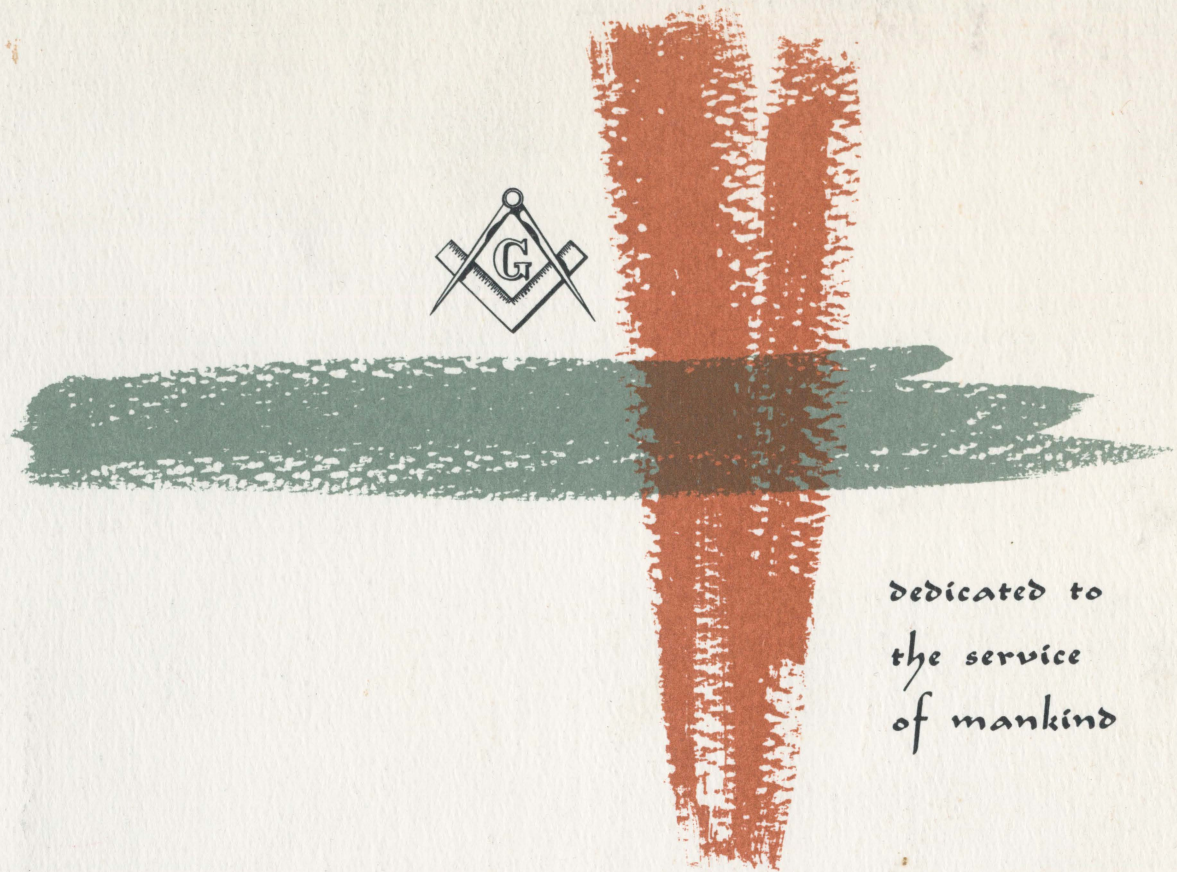

YOU ASK:

HOW MAY WE HELP YOU? WHAT DOES THE HOSPITAL NEED?

For hospital development and patient care, the 600 bed Illinois Masonic Hospital needs:

ENDOWMENTS:

An endowment may be a general purpose gift from you to provide a perpetual memorial. Or you may designate a specific sum to be used for a particular installation, service or as part of hospital care. An endowment may be large or small. Your contribution will be applied as you wish. Vitally needed facilities awaiting endowment include:

NEW ROOMS

New construction atop the Wellington Street Building will allow for new rooms to care for additional patients. A room shortage—has long held back hospital development. Donors may endow a single room for from \$1,000 to \$5,000. The cost of a ward — \$25,000.

FREE BEDS

A free bed given toward the care of those unable to pay is a fraternal and a compassionate endowment. You can donate a month's bed stay — \$500 — a year's stay, \$5,000.

DIAGNOSTIC BEDS

The foundations of the Wellington Street Addition are designed to support eight stories. An entire floor of the proposed eight story structure will be set aside for diagnostic studies. This floor will, in effect, be a "Hospital Hotel" for special patients under observation who will have complete freedom of the hospital. Their nursing service will be unobtrusive and non-intensive. Meals for such ambulatory patients will be served in a special dining hall on this floor. Cost of the diagnostic unit — \$200,000.



PULMONARY FUNCTION LABORATORY

Highly specialized tests by highly trained technicians require delicate and expensive equipment. Cost of the pulmonary laboratory concentrating on diseases of the chest — \$10,000.

PSYCHIATRY DEPARTMENT

Treatment of mental disturbances is of increasing importance in the modern hospital. A psychiatric unit of 30 beds is a most important project. Cost of the new psychiatric department — \$150,000.



STUDENT NURSE TRAINING

Illinois Masonic is a teaching, training and research hospital. A gift of only \$260 will provide a student nurse's tuition, instruction in and out of class, living quarters, uniforms, textbooks, etc. Cost of student nurse for nurses training for 3 years — \$260.

EXPANSION OF NURSES' HOME

Two hundred fifty student nurses are now in training. To house an additional 100 nurses essential to the expanded hospital, the capacity of the Thomas O. Wallace Nurses' Residence must be increased by two complete floors. The cost — \$250,000.

DIAGNOSTIC AND TREATMENT SECTION

New space and facilities for the reception and care of out — and ambulatory patients can be provided by adding a floor to the present 1 story Wellington Street Building. The cost — \$100,000.

QUARTERS FOR MARRIED INTERNS

Married interns must be provided with adequate living quarters. This requires suitable accommodations for 40 couples. The cost — \$50,000.

CARDIAC CATHETERIZATION STATION

To make possible advanced techniques in heart surgery, catheterization facilities are urgently needed. The station cost — \$25,000.

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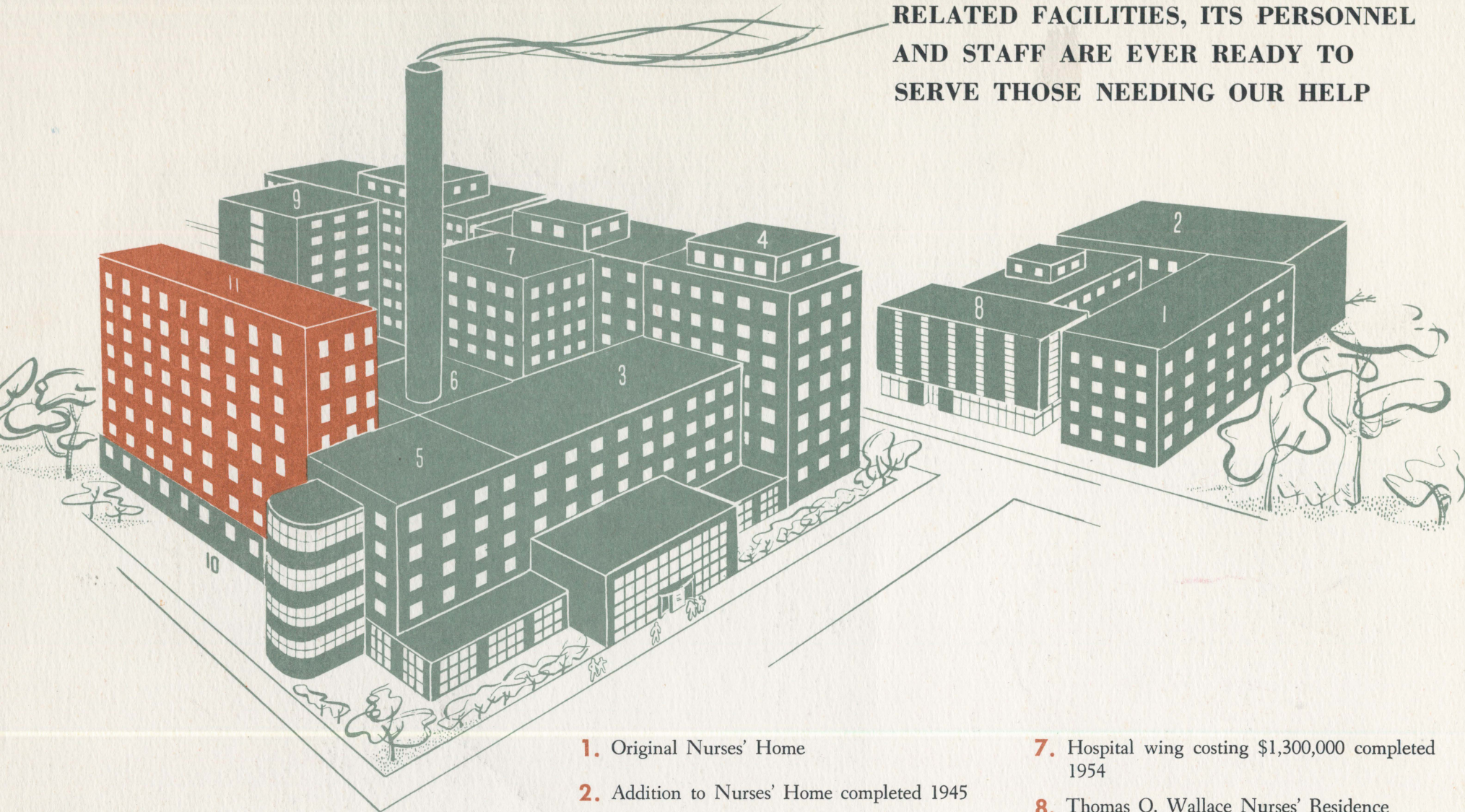
